

DIRECT INSTALL FROM NJCEP TRANSITION



Direct Install from *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program™* (NJCEP) will be ending in June 2021 and transitioning to a new format where it will be the responsibility of New Jersey's utilities to implement and manage.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Think of this as an efficient upgrade to energy efficiency programs.
- This transition will allow the utilities to work directly with customers to achieve energy savings.
- Direct Install from NJCEP will continue to accept project submissions up until the end of June.
- As long as you have a project submitted and approved by June 30th, the NJCEP will still honor your project.
- We are continuing to promote and qualify Direct Install projects up until the June 30th cut off.
- The Board of Public Utilities is currently reviewing the utilities' program proposals.
- Utility programs are expected to start phasing in beginning Spring 2021 and continuing through the year.
